

SMSA Secondary School Transfer Evening Key Information

State Schools (Including selective state schools)

Key date: 31st October 2013

This is the closing date for applications via your local education authority. Please note that if you are applying to a selective state school or for a music place at a state school you must contact the school directly for additional **application** forms. These forms will have to be completed and returned to the school as directed by the school you are applying for – the deadline is usually before 31st October.

Full and further useful details of open days etc. are available on the schools' and local authorities' website. This list has been carefully compiled by the SMSA and should be used only as a guide. While every effort has been made to ensure it is accurate, parents and/or carers should make their own enquiries in advance of any applications.

There are several types of state schools:

- **Community:** are schools owned and maintained by the Council. The council has overall responsibility for the community schools' admissions and the council arranges appeals for places at these schools.
- **Foundation:** funded by the council but the governing bodies of individual schools own the buildings, are responsible for setting the admissions criteria and handling the process including the arrangement of appeals.
- **Voluntary Aided:** funded by the council but "voluntary bodies" (usually religious) own the buildings and the governors of the schools are responsible for setting the admissions criteria, handling the process and arranging appeals.
- **Free:** are all-ability state-funded schools set up in response to what local people say they want and need in order to improve education for children in their community.
- **Academies:** are independent schools but no fees are charged to parents and they are required to participate in coordinated admission arrangements. The governing body is responsible for setting the admission criteria and for arranging appeals.
